FILING A TITLE IX COMPLAINT: WHERE TO GO

- You may also file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education's Office for Civil
 Rights (OCR), if you believe your school has failed to properly investigate complaints:

 Education)
- Your school may have additional resources available, such as confidential services or counseling, and you can always contact the National Sexual Assault Hotline at 800.656.HOPE (4673), or you can also visit hotline.rainn.org/online
- You may (but are not required to) file a police report about the incident. Your rights under Title IX will not be affected either way.
